- 1 Spark a discussion**  
Create a grid for your classroom and add unlimited discussion topics
- 2 Students share**  
Students capture and share ideas through video on any device
- 3 Everyone engages**  
All students view and reply to take the discussion deeper

## 1. Create Your Grid

- \*free version only allows 1 grid to be created- that grid can have unlimited topics posted
- if using free version put class section in title of discussion topic ex. introduction (History period 1)
- \*paid version allows unlimited grids (this allows each class to have its own grid, with a unique url and password)

--Each topic that is posted is given a unique url

**Create a New Grid**

Grids are a classroom or community of learners

**1. Grid Details**

**Grid Name (required)**  
What your grid will be called  
Training

**Customize Grid Code** (Custom grid codes only available in Flipgrid Classroom)  
How users will access your grid

**2. Security and Privacy**

**Password Protection**  
Setting a password requires users to enter a password to access the grid topic or response. Also: Protecting the grid will also disable the Social Share link setting.

**Share Links**  
How users will share a grid topic or response on Facebook or Google Classroom.

**Moderate Responses**  
If responses are moderated, the grid owner must approve each response prior to it being visible in the grid.

**3. Features**

**Notify Me**  
Receive an email notification when new responses are added to any topic in the grid.

**Keywords**  
Display auto-generated keywords.

**Transcriptions**  
Display auto-generated transcriptions.

**Create a New Topic**

Topic Title (required)  
What is the subject of this topic? (max 200 characters)  
Introduce Yourself

**1. Topic Details**

**Video Response Time** (required)  
How long will it take to respond to this question? (min 30 seconds)  
3 minute, 30 seconds

**2. Topic Description/Question (required)**  
What is the question or topic for this grid? (max 2000 characters)

**3. Features**

**Allow**  
Allowing a topic makes it visible to users.

**Requires Email for Responses**  
Require respondents to provide an email address to submit their video.

**Replies to Responses**  
Only authors can respond to a response.

**Video Likes**  
Display the number of likes a response has received.

**Video Views**  
Display the number of views a response has received.

**Freeze**  
Prevent users from submitting new videos that no longer meet the criteria.

## 2. Create a Topic

- \*topics are the posts students will respond to
- \*free version does not allow you to modify the time limit
- teachers can require students to provide their email to submit the video

\*Paid version allows students to reply to each other's posts

\*Grid Topics can also be shared as QR codes and embedded (need the paid version for the embedded Grid to be fully functional)

-- Topics can include an embedded YouTube or Vimeo video, an image, text, a fun Giphy or Emoji, a website url, or even an attached file (OneNote, Google Docs, etc.)
