

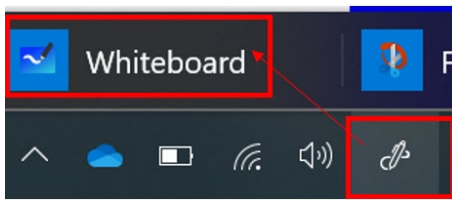

Below are the steps that need taken on the Touch Panel TVs for inking to work in Office & PDFs.

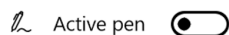
This has also needed done on some of the newer SMARTBoards.

***Steps 1-4 should only need done once.

1. Connect to the Sharp Smart Panel / SMARTboard / SMART Panel
2. Open Microsoft Whiteboard



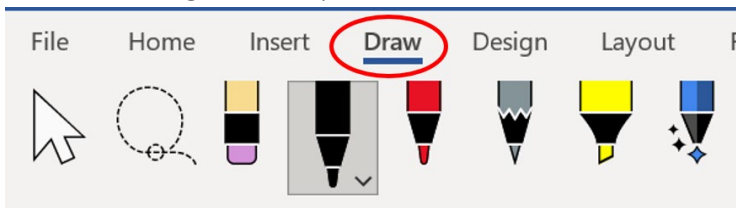
3. Click on the settings menu
4. Turn active pen off



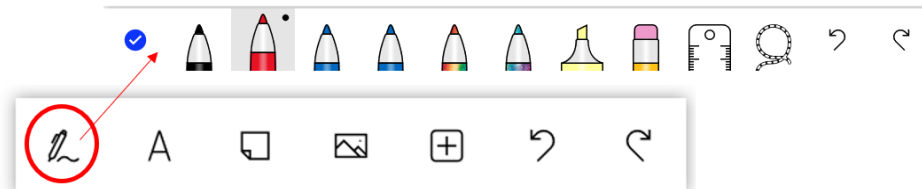
5. Now when you open Word, PowerPoint, Microsoft Whiteboard, Adobe etc. you can choose any pen or highlighter to annotate with.

*Open the file > pick up the pen/stylus (or use your finger) > click to open the pen toolbar (see details below) > click on the pen or highlighter you would like to use

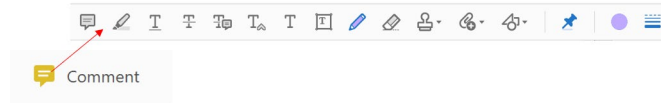
--In Office Programs the pen tools are under "Draw"



--In Microsoft Whiteboard, the pen tools are under the pen icon

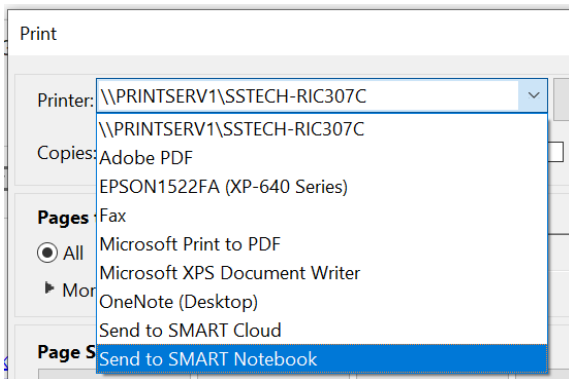


-In Adobe, the pen tools are under the 'Comment' option

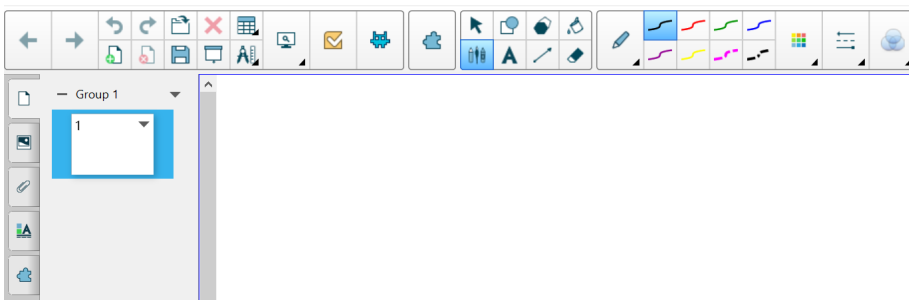


Reminder: You can always PRINT any file type to SMART Notebook to create a SMART Notebook file.
